1 Peter 1

Questions:

How does Peter describe the living hope believers have through the resurrection of Jesus Christ?

Reflect on the significance of being “born again to a living hope.” How does this shape your perspective on life?

What does Peter say about the trials believers face, and how do they serve to refine faith?

How are believers called to live in response to God’s holiness and the redemption through Christ?

Personal Reflection Question: How can you cultivate a lifestyle of hope, holiness, and reverence for God in your daily life?

1 Peter 2

Questions:

How does Peter describe believers as living stones and a spiritual house?

Reflect on the identity of believers as a chosen race, a royal priesthood, and a holy nation. How does this identity impact your sense of purpose?

What does Peter say about submitting to authority, and how can this be applied in various aspects of your life?

How are believers called to follow Christ's example in suffering and injustice?

Personal Reflection Question: In what areas of your life can you more fully embrace your identity in Christ and live out the values of God's kingdom?

1 Peter 3

Questions:

What instructions does Peter give to wives and husbands, and how can these principles foster healthy relationships?

How does Peter encourage believers to respond to suffering for doing good?

1 Peter 4

Questions:

How does Peter describe the attitude believers should have toward suffering and sin?

Reflect on the importance of living for the will of God rather than human desires. How can this focus shape your daily decisions?

What instructions does Peter give regarding love, hospitality, and the use of spiritual gifts?

How does Peter encourage believers to rejoice in suffering for Christ's sake?

Personal Reflection Question: How can you prioritize God's will in your life, using your gifts to serve others and glorify Him, even in difficult circumstances?

1 Peter 5

Questions:

What instructions does Peter give to elders and young men, and how do these principles apply to leadership and humility in the church?

Reflect on the call to cast all your cares on God because He cares for you. How can you practice this trust and reliance on God in your life?

How does Peter warn against the devil's schemes, and what strategies does he offer for resisting him?

What promises does Peter highlight about God's grace and restoration after suffering?

Personal Reflection Question: How can you cultivate a heart of humility, vigilance, and steadfastness in your faith, trusting in God's care and promises?

2 Peter 1

Questions:

What does Peter say about making one's calling and election sure?

How does Peter emphasize the reliability of the prophetic message and the testimony of the apostles?

Personal Reflection Question: How can you ensure that you are growing in the qualities listed by Peter, and how does this growth affirm your calling and election in Christ?

2 Peter 2

Questions:

How does Peter describe false teachers, and what warnings does he give about their influence?

Reflect on the examples of God's judgment and rescue in the past. How do these examples reinforce the seriousness of false teaching?

What characteristics and behaviors of false teachers does Peter highlight?

How can you discern and protect yourself from false teachings and influences?

Personal Reflection Question: In what ways can you stay vigilant and grounded in the truth to avoid being led astray by false teachings?

2 Peter 3

Questions:

What does Peter say about the promise of the Lord's coming and the skepticism surrounding it?

Reflect on the reasons Peter gives for the Lord's apparent delay. How does this shape your understanding of God's timing and patience?

How should believers live in light of the coming day of the Lord?

What final exhortations does Peter give to believers about growing in grace and knowledge?

1 John

Questions:

How does John describe the message he has heard and declares to the readers?

Reflect on the significance of walking in the light versus walking in darkness. What does this mean for your daily life?

What does John say about confessing our sins and God's faithfulness and justice to forgive?

How does fellowship with God and others play a role in our spiritual journey?

Personal Reflection Question: How can you walk in the light and maintain fellowship with God and fellow believers?

1 John 2

Questions:

What does John say about obeying God's commands and the evidence of knowing Him?

Reflect on the new commandment to love one another. How is this both old and new?

How does John describe the dangers of loving the world and the things in it?

What warnings does John give about antichrists and remaining in the truth?

Personal Reflection Question: In what ways can you demonstrate your love for God by obeying His commands and loving others?

1 John 3

Questions:

How does John describe the love that the Father has lavished on us, and what does it mean to be called children of God?

Reflect on the difference between the children of God and the children of the devil. How can this understanding guide your actions?

What does John say about loving one another in action and truth, not just words?

How does confidence before God come from keeping His commands and doing what pleases Him?

Personal Reflection Question: How can you show genuine love through your actions and maintain a confident relationship with God?

1 John 4

Questions:

How does John instruct believers to test the spirits to see whether they are from God?

Reflect on the nature of God's love and the call to love one another. How does this shape your understanding of love?

What does John say about the relationship between love and fear?

How does John describe the connection between loving God and loving our brothers and sisters?

Personal Reflection Question: How can you live out the perfect love that drives out fear and demonstrates your love for God and others?

1 John 5

Questions:

What does John say about the victory that overcomes the world, and how is it related to our faith?

Reflect on the testimony God has given about His Son. How does this testimony affirm your faith in Jesus?

What confidence does John give regarding asking anything according to God's will?

How does John conclude his letter, emphasizing the importance of staying away from idols?

Personal Reflection Question: How can you live in the victory that comes from faith in Jesus, confidently praying according to God's will and staying true to Him?

2 John

Questions:

How does John emphasize the importance of walking in truth and love?

Reflect on the warnings about deceivers who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh. How can you guard against such deception?

What instructions does John give about showing hospitality to those who bring this false teaching?

How does John describe the joy of finding others walking in the truth?

Personal Reflection Question: In what ways can you actively walk in truth and love, ensuring that you are not led astray by false teachings?

3 John

Questions:

How does John commend Gaius for his faithfulness and support of fellow believers?

Reflect on the contrast between Gaius and Diotrephes. What qualities are praised or condemned?

What does John say about imitating what is good versus what is evil?

How does John express his desire for fellowship and face-to-face communication?

Personal Reflection Question: How can you support and encourage fellow believers, imitating what is good and fostering genuine fellowship?

Jude

Questions:

How does Jude describe the need to contend for the faith once delivered to the saints?

Reflect on the examples Jude gives of those who perished due to unbelief, disobedience, and rebellion. How do these serve as warnings?

What does Jude say about false teachers and their characteristics?

How does Jude encourage believers to build themselves up in their most holy faith and keep themselves in God's love?

Personal Reflection Question: In what ways can you contend for your faith, staying grounded in God's love and avoiding the pitfalls of false teachings?
